- **An HL7 Message Viewer is now available for provider offices that are on transfer.** You can access the HL7 Message Viewer by clicking the HL7 Message Viewer link in the Import/Export box on your MCIR home screen. In the message viewer you can view a calendar of what HL7 messages have come across to MCIR and when. If you click on a particular day you can look in detail at the raw data messages that were sent to MCIR. Providers are only able to view messages for sites they are associated with as a user. A MCIR User Reference Guide: HL7 Message Viewer will be available soon and will be posted at www.mcir.org.

VFC E-ORDER PROJECTION SCREEN

- MCIR Vaccines for Children (VFC) E-Order Projection Screen has been added to the e-order screen in MCIR. The screen now shows a one month and three month projection which is calculated based on your current on-hand inventory of a vaccine and the average monthly doses you have given of that vaccine over the past three months. Doses that are highlighted in pink represent quantities of doses being ordered that do not fall within the projections.

If you have doses highlighted in pink an “Override Reason” screen will pop up so you can select a reason for each vaccine that is outside of the projected quantity. The options are Recall, Back to School, Disease Outbreak, Special Clinic, or New Vaccine.

Another item you will see is a notification on the shipping screen. The notifications include a back to school reminder, a flu season reminder, and a reminder to carry all ACIP recommended vaccines. These reminders will be displayed based on the time of year and inventory.

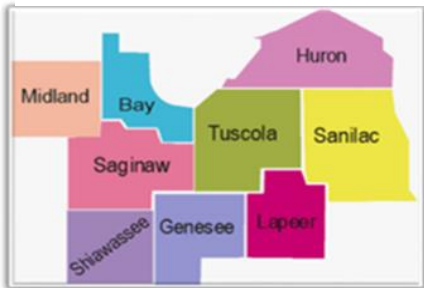
Notifications

MCIR Options

- MCIR Users that are designated as a Site Administrator have the ability to add and delete site users and edit site information on their site. Please see the helpful tip sheets section listed on the left of this newsletter for links to tip sheets and videos that explain how to edit your site.
- It has been reported that sometimes the “Submit” button will disappear from the VFC E-Ordering “Override Reason” box. This is not a MCIR bug, but usually a browser issue. Try clicking on the box with your mouse and shake it which can cause the button to return. Trying a different browser may also resolve the issue.
- Just a reminder to VFC providers. When doing your refrigerator counts for your physical inventory always remember to count at the end of the day when vaccinations are completed. If the count takes place in the morning always use the previous day in MCIR. For a review please see Step #2 of the VIM Balance Inventory Tip Sheet that located on the left of this newsletter in the tip sheets section.

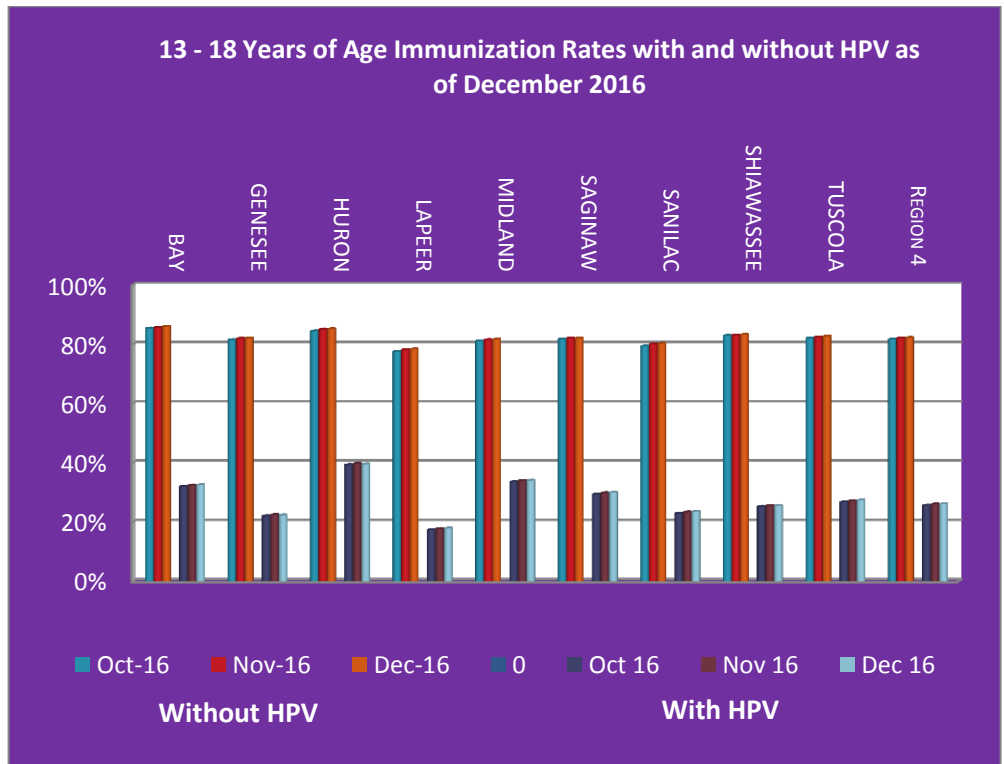
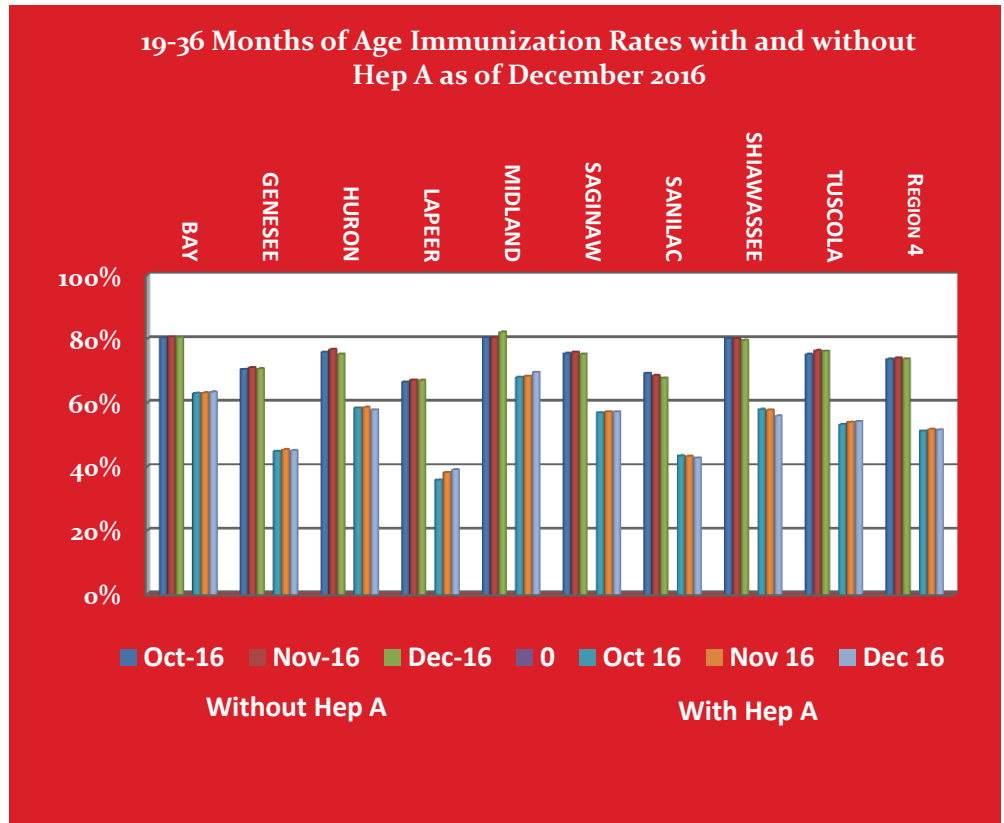
