

Remember while boating:

- Know the signs of carbon monoxide poisoning. An odorless, colorless gas, carbon monoxide is emitted from engines, such as boat engines or onboard motor generators.
- Check local weather conditions and forecasts before boating.
- Watch for dangerous waves and signs of rip currents. Some examples are water that is discolored and choppy, foamy, or filled with debris and moving in a channel away from shore.
- Be prepared! Take the time to develop a float plan in case of emergency.
