MCIR UPDATES

- MDHHS has a new process for the MCIR Regions to log potential MCIR defects (bugs). The new process requires us to provide more detail including the steps that were taken by the provider and the browser being used at the time of the issue. If you experience an issue in MCIR that you think may be a defect please remember to document the steps you took when you experienced the problem and what browser you were using. If the issue involves a report or other information please do not delete it as it will be needed to help verify the problem. Provide specific MCIR IDs when possible. Before an issue is logged we will need to review it. Thank you for your patience and your willingness to provide more detail as we all get acclimated to this new process.

Generating an AFIX Report in MCIR

Providers can generate and retrieve an AFIX report in MCIR to identify patients overdue for immunizations and to spot missed immunizations and opportunities for their patient vaccines needs. Utilizing the AFIX provides providers a tool to assist in fine tuning immunization practices and protocol in their office. Questions about how to utilize the AFIX reports should be directed to the immunization staff at your LHD/County health department or the MDHHS AFIX Coordinator. MCIR Moments

➤ At the Region 4 Helpdesk we have been receiving many calls from people asking for their MCIR Pin #. After further discussion we usually determine that the person has signed up for MiLogin for Third Party before they were ever added to MCIR as a site user. The correct process is to add the new user to the MCIR site first. When the user is added to your MCIR site they will receive a system generated e-mail with their MCIR Pin #. Completing these steps in the proper order will allow the new user to get access quicker and reduce their frustration. ➤ If you have employees that retire or leave your office for another job opportunity, please remember to delete them off of your site. This can be done by the site provider administrator by clicking the garbage can to the right of their name when you are in the MCIR Users tab on your site. Employees that are left on your site still have access to your site’s information in MCIR.

➤ Flu vaccination season is here. If you are a site that uses HL7 data transfer it may be useful to run Electronic Submission Summary Reports (ESSR) more frequently to catch any errors quickly during this flu season. The vaccine code sheet was updated and posted on www.mcir.org on 9/22/2017. Please see a link in the “Tip Sheets and More” section.

➤ Just a reminder to VFC providers. When completing a vaccine lot transaction some of the actions and reasons allow the user to choose the inventory effect and the LWB effect. When completing a transaction that allows you to choose, be mindful that you are selecting the correct effect that you want it to have on your inventory. If the transaction does not result in any lost, wasted or borrowed remember to select N/A for the LWB effect. For a chart of the actions and reasons including the inventory effect please see pages 24-27 of the VIM Reference Guide on your left in the “Tips and More” section.

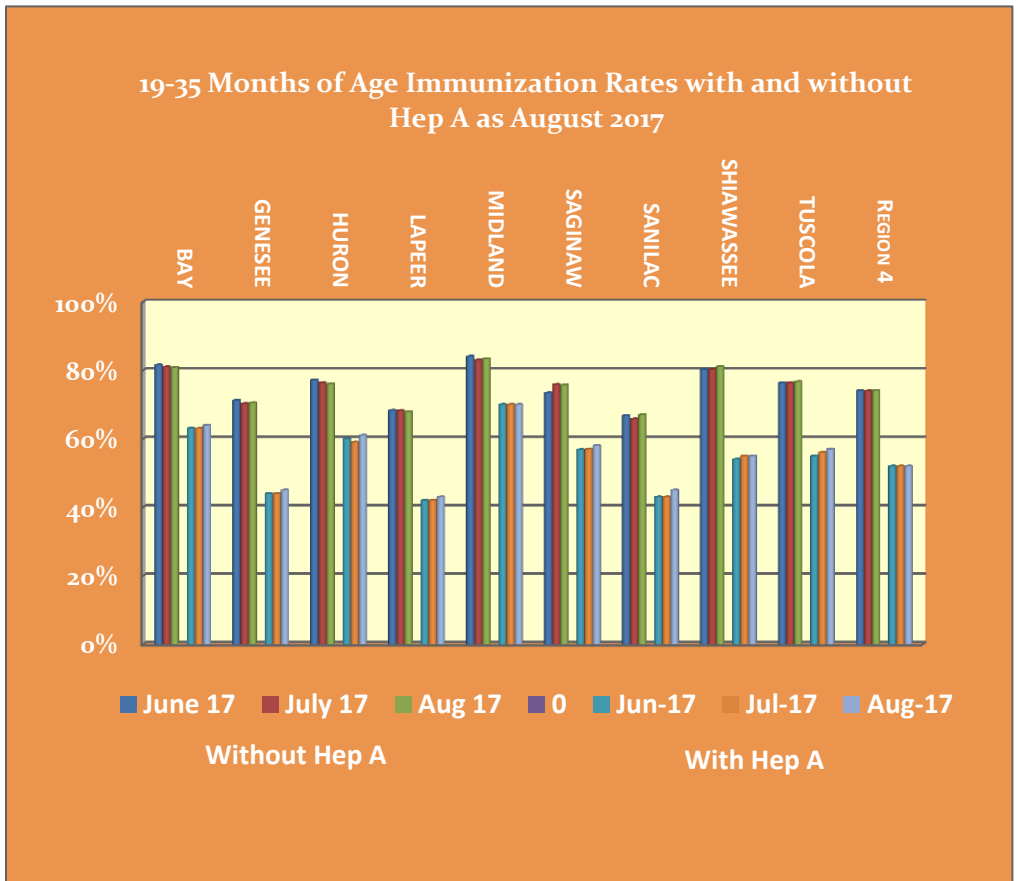

ages 13-18 Years**

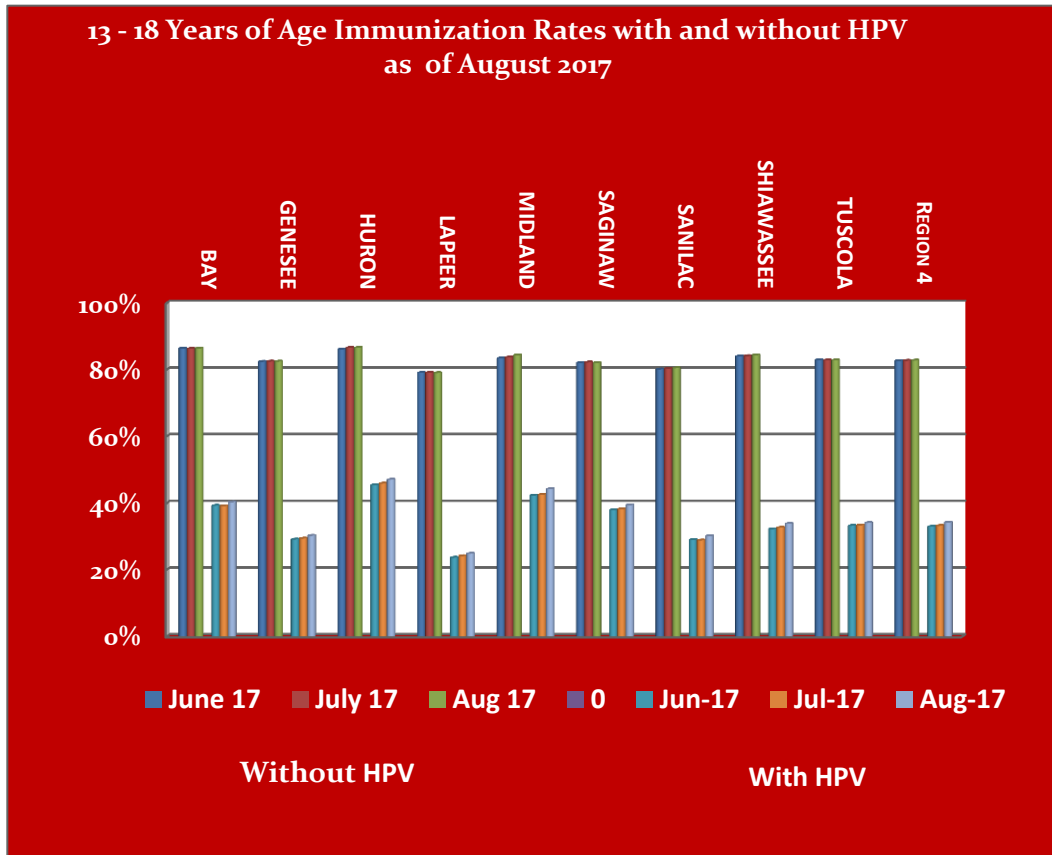
