Patients who do not have insurance can apply for a discount (sliding fee) on services. To apply for the sliding fee scale, patients need proof of income such as pay stub, W-2, tax return, food stamp card, or DHS benefits letter. Help is also available for those who do not have prescription coverage and meet income and eligibility guidelines. Proof of income is required.</p>
